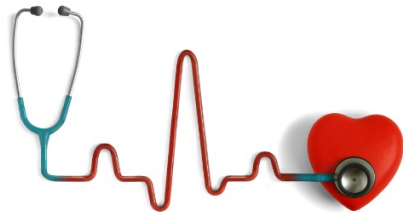




# Southwest Miami Senior High School



**Medical Assisting** provides students with clinical and administrative skills to work in a doctor's office, ambulatory care centers, and urgent care centers. They can complete the National Healthcare Association Certified Medical Administrative Assistant (CMAA), The National Healthcare Association Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA), the Allied Health Certification, the Phlebotomy Occupational Completer Points, the American Heart Association Healthcare Provider Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Certification, and the National Healthcare Association Electrocardiography (EKG) Technician Certification. Affiliation to HOSA (Future Health Professionals), an international student organization recognized by the U.S. Department of Education and the Health Science Education Division of ACTE is also offered. The Medical Assisting Diploma can be completed at Southwest Miami High School.

10<sup>th</sup> grade: Health Science Foundations  
11<sup>th</sup> grade: Electrocardiograph Aide 3 (.5 credit) and Health Occupations Education (.5 credit)  
12<sup>th</sup> grade: Allied Health Assisting 3 (1 credit) and Executive Internship 1 (1 credit)
