Expectations

- ▶ Students participating in dual enrollment must earn a grade of "C" or higher in their college-level courses and maintain an unweighted 3.0 GPA in high school to continue participation. Students whose college GPA falls below 2.0 are ineligible to continue dual enrollment.
- ▶ Students may lose eligibility if they are disruptive to the learning process.
- ▶ All Dual Enrollment courses must be approved by their secondary school counselors.
- ▶ Courses taken in Dual Enrollment will be used to meet the student's high school graduation requirement.

What Does DE Look Like on Schedule? Here are Two Examples...

 - ▶ Period 3: AP Capstone
 - ▶ Period 4: DE SLS/ DE Psych of Self
 - ▶ Period 5: Banking + Finance Magnet
 - ▶ Period 6: DE Modern Dance/ DE Ballet Techniques
 - ▶ Period 7: AP Biology
 - ▶ Period 8: Elective
- ▶ Period 1: DE SLS/ DE Psych of Self
 - ▶ Period 2: English through ESOL 3
 - ▶ Period 3: .NET Academy class
 - ▶ Period 4: US History
 - ▶ Period 5: Elective
 - ▶ Period 6: Developmental ESOL 3
 - ▶ Period 7: Algebra 2
 - ▶ Period 8: Biology or Environmental Science

Your CORE classes and any MAGNET/ACADEMY classes need to be scheduled in before we can see if you have space in your schedule! You should also not have Intensive Reading and/or Intensive Math.
